BIODIVERSITY POLICY





One of Cupa Group's main goals in its environmental leadership is to preserve biodiversity and the natural heritage. Biodiversity is a key value for Cupa Group because of the value it generates in a large part of the areas surrounding our activities, and for that reason promotes their conservation to facilitate social and economic development.

Principles

- Respect protected areas of high ecological value in our surroundings.
- Establish conservation of the natural heritage and biodiversity as a key element in Cupa Group strategic decisions over planning, operating and withdrawing from production activities.
- Minimize as far as possible biodiversity loss in work areas that have to be extended or expanded.
- Control and minimize the impacts on biodiversity in the various areas with potential impact on the natural environment due to our activities.
- Participate in projects that help to preserve biodiversity.
- Publicize, disseminate, train and raise awareness of biodiversity among employees and other stakeholders by transmitting good practices and a variety of biodiversity topics.
- Restore the natural environment whenever possible using the best techniques and preserving the natural ecological value of the areas.
- Make changes in facilities to measure the organization's environmental performance in biodiversity.
- Inspect the facilities to measure the organization's environmental performance in biodiversity, achieving an implementation value of this monthly system by 2025 of at least 90% in production and extraction centers with 2021 as the baseline year.
- With 2021 as the baseline year, by 2025 increase participation in biodiversity conservation projects by 50%.
- Monitor biodiversity indicators periodically.
