

ENVIRONMENTAL OBJECTIVES 2026–2030

Objectives linked to the environmental and energy policy:

- Reduce non-renewable energy consumption by 3% per year until 2030, based on the group's total energy consumption relative to revenue.
- Reduce CO₂ emissions by 3% per year from total group emissions until 2030, based on revenue.
- Reduce hazardous waste generated by 1% until 2030 in slate production sites, the main producers of this waste, based on revenue.
- Reduce non-recycled materials by using at least 2% recycled plastics by weight until 2030 in the packaging of materials commercialised by the slate and stone companies, as these are the entities that directly package products.
- Increase training hours on environmental matters provided by third parties to staff of CUPA GROUP companies by 10% until 2030, covering the following topics: emissions and energy, climate change, water consumption, biodiversity, materials consumption, and hazardous waste and products.

Objectives linked to the biodiversity policy:

- Increase participation in biodiversity conservation projects by 10% by 2030, using 2025 as the baseline.

Objectives linked to the water management policy:

- Reduce water consumption by 5% by 2030 in a pilot slate processing plant through technical improvements aimed at water savings and recovery optimisation.



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
